Stardust@home looking for Internet volunteers

University of California, Berkeley, researchers are looking for a few hawk-eyed volunteers to find about 45 grains of submicroscopic dust. The Berkeley group at the campus' Space Sciences Laboratory will create a "virtual microscope" for volunteers with Internet access to scan about 1.5 million pictures of the aerogel for stardust tracks. Discoverers will get to name the dust grains they find. The hunt will begin in March 2006.
