*** ENG 398 SW: Success in the Workplace**

Any undergraduate student (both within and outside the University of Illinois) with a concurrent internship or co-op is eligible for the course, which provides two hours of credit.

The purpose of the course is to help students internalize their internship experience and to enhance their understanding of their role within the company. Course topics include basic business concepts (such as marketing, strategy, and corporate finance), interpersonal skills (such as networking and leadership), communication skills, and project management. Lectures and quizzes will be delivered via the internet, and there is a multi-part project of which students will complete a portion each week during the 8-week course.
